Summary

- Ørjasæter is a 22-year-old left winger who stands out as one of the more dynamic wide attackers in the Eredivisie. His profile is built around attacking volume, direct carries, 1v1 threat and consistent involvement in advanced left-sided zones.
- He does not only stay wide to cross. He regularly drives into the final third, enters the box and creates chances from both the left channel and the left half-space, giving Twente a reliable route into dangerous areas.
- His main value comes through chance creation and ball carrying. He provides key passes, creates separation through dribbles and turns wide possession into direct penalty-area threat.
- The main development point is end-product efficiency. He gets into good attacking positions and produces regular shots, but his goal return remains low compared to his level of involvement.
- Overall, Ørjasæter profiles as a high-impact creative winger with clear upside. In the right attacking structure, his carrying, creativity and box access can make him a valuable wide outlet, while finishing and turnover management remain the main areas to monitor.

Strengths

- **Creative facilitator:** High-level chance creator from the left side, with strong key-pass and xA output.
- **Ball carrying:** Repeatedly progresses play through carries, dribbles and aggressive final-third actions.
- **Box access:** Consistently enters and receives in the box, creating danger beyond wide delivery.
- **1v1 threat:** Confident taking defenders on, using balance, timing and body control to create separation.

Development Areas

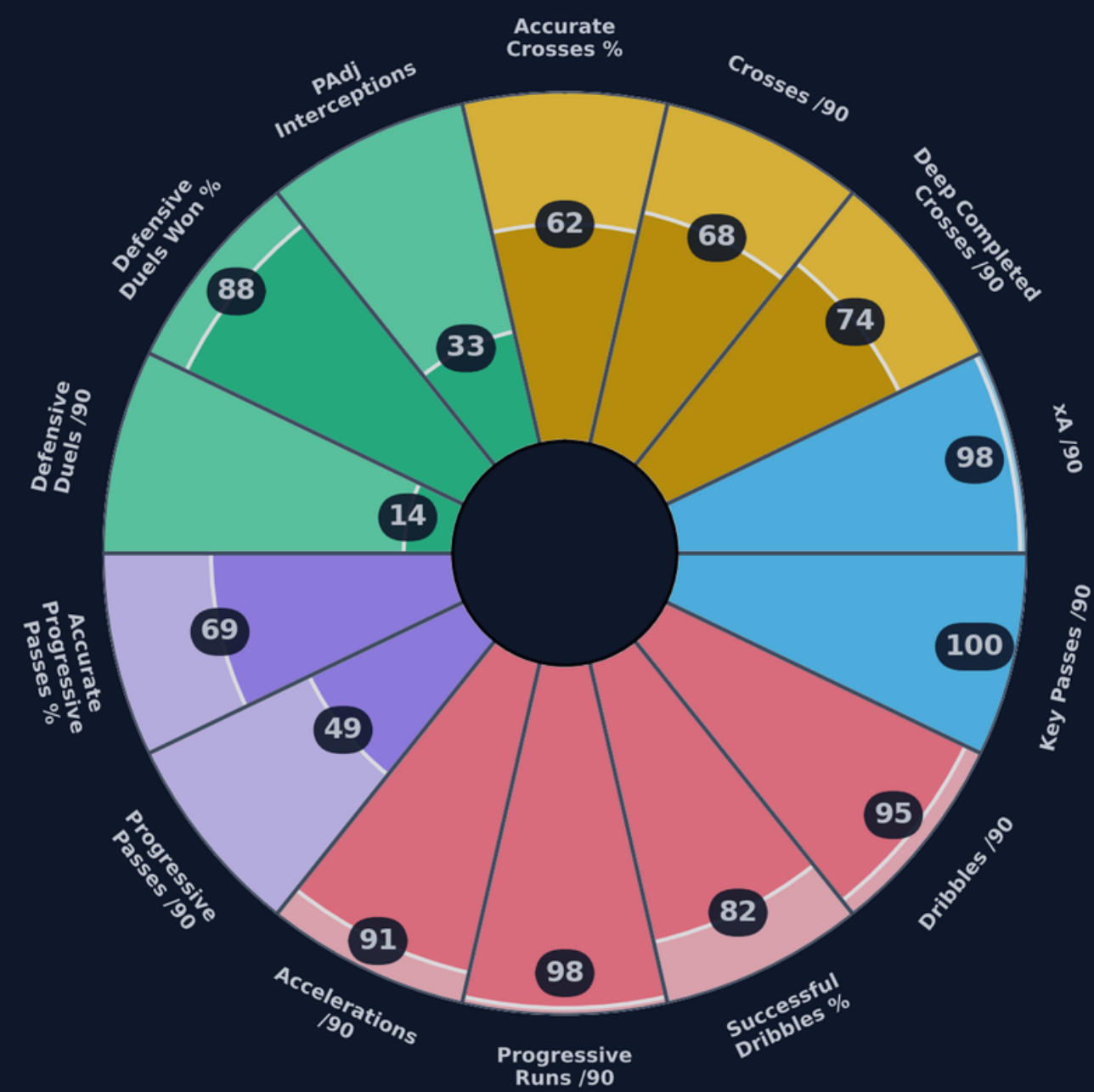
- **Finishing efficiency:** Gets into good shooting areas, but his goal return remains low.
- **Turnover management:** High-volume carrying brings value, but also creates possession-loss risk.
- **Defensive engagement volume:** Contributes through recoveries, but is not a dominant defensive dueller.
- **Aerial impact:** Limited effectiveness in aerial duels, reducing his value as a direct wide outlet.

Tactical Fit

- **Best role:** Left winger in a system that supports wide forwards, with freedom to receive in depth, attack inside and enter the box.
- **In possession:** Fits best in a high-territory team that reaches the final third often and gives him the support to attack space and engage in 1v1 situations.
- **Out of possession:** Best protected in a team with strong counterpressing and rest defence, as his high-volume carries naturally create turnover risk.
- **Less suitable fit:** Lower-possession sides that ask him to defend deep for long periods or play as a low-risk touchline winger would reduce his attacking value.

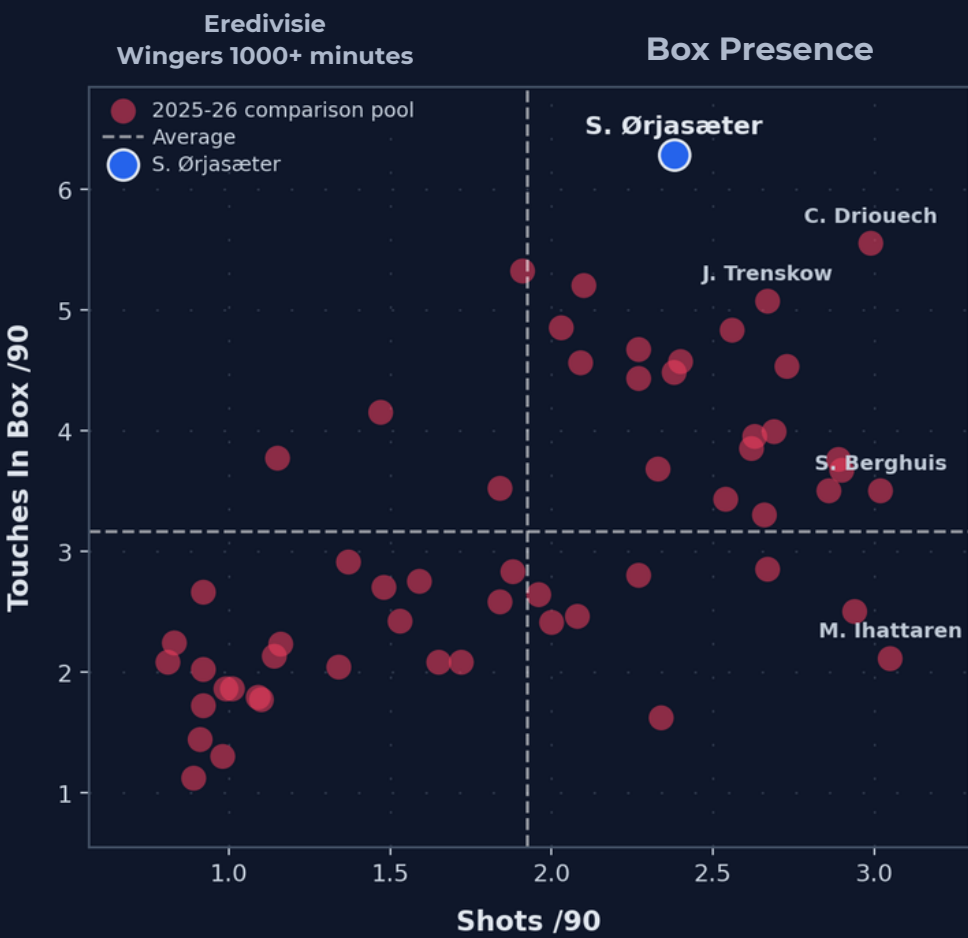
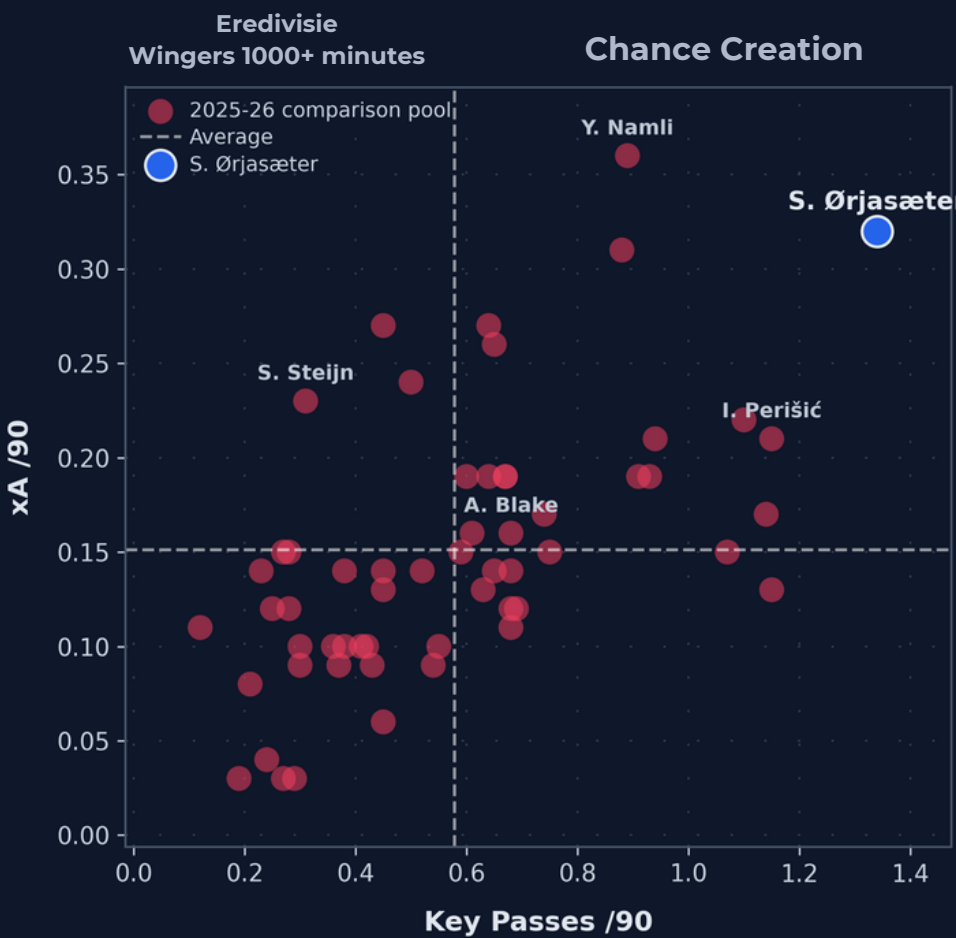

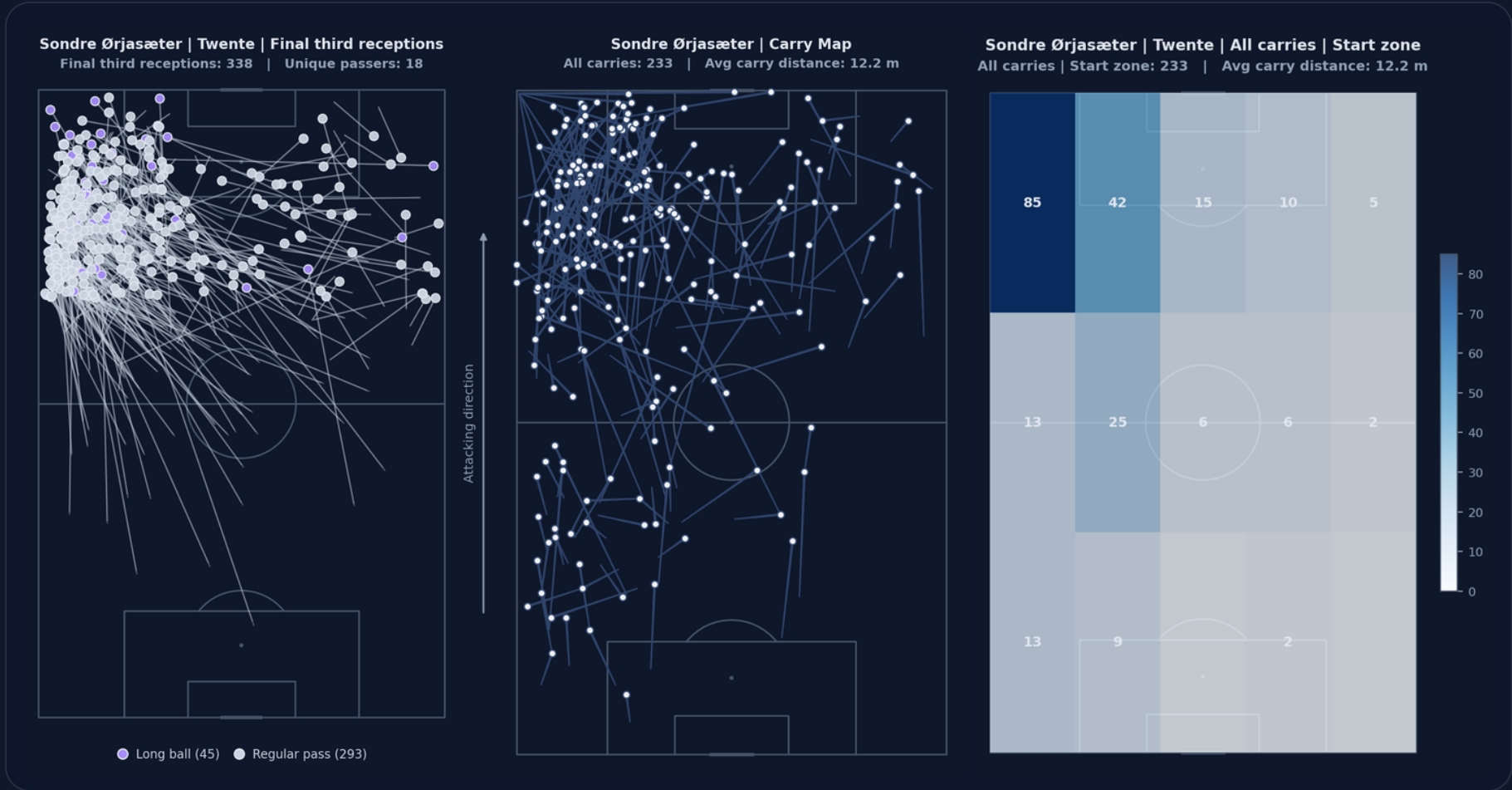
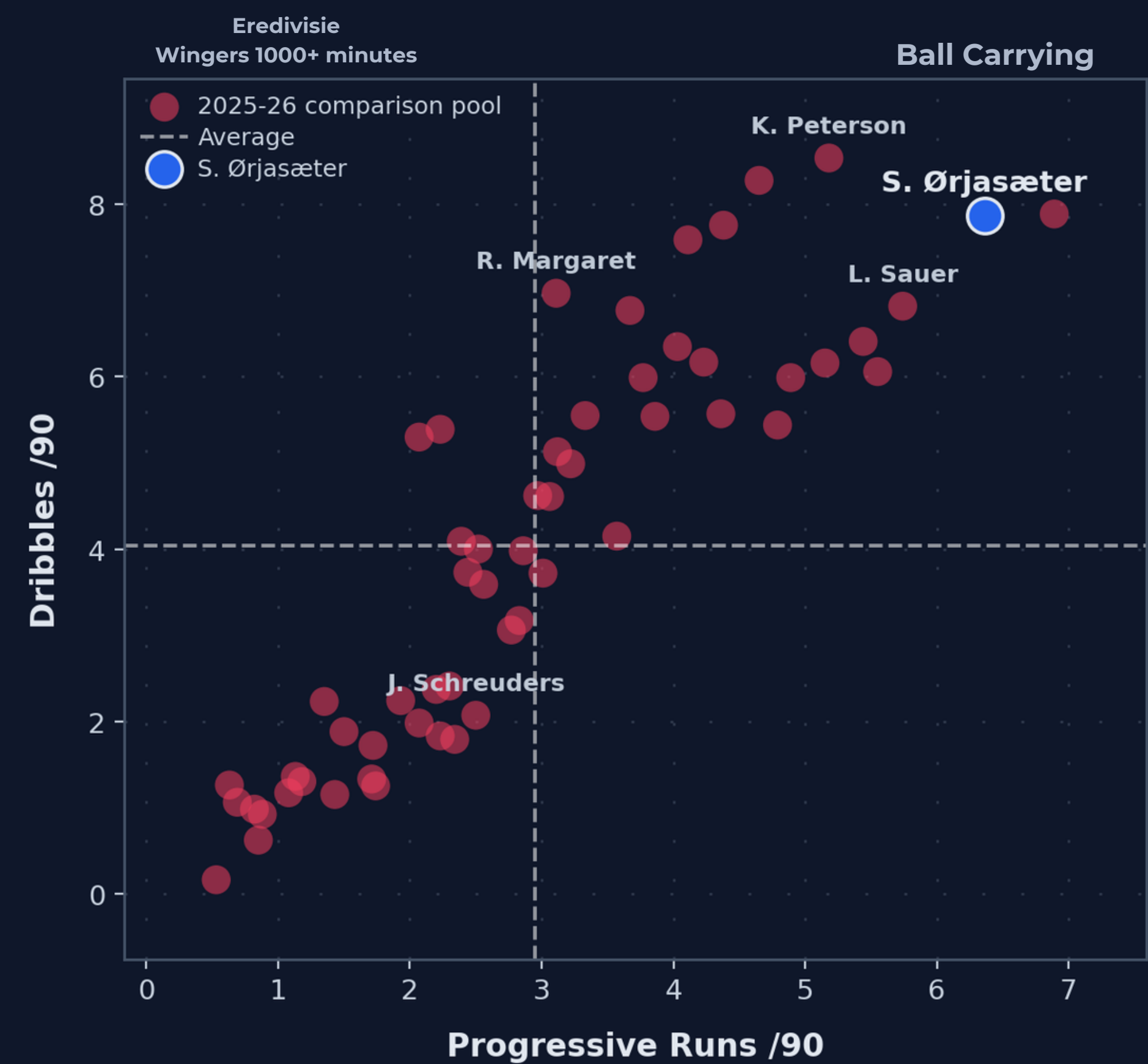


Scout Interpretation

- Ørjasæter's data profile shows a winger with high attacking volume and clear final-third influence, especially through key passes, xA, dribbles, progressive runs and repeated involvement close to goal.
- His creative numbers underline a player who does not only circulate possession, but regularly turns left-sided attacks into valuable chances for teammates.
- The shot and box-touch relationship highlights a winger with real penalty-area presence, showing that he can attack dangerous zones himself rather than only creating from outside.
- His ball-carrying profile is a major separator, with strong output in dribbles, successful dribbles, accelerations and progressive runs.
- The main limitation is the balance between impact and efficiency, with finishing output and turnover management still important areas to monitor.

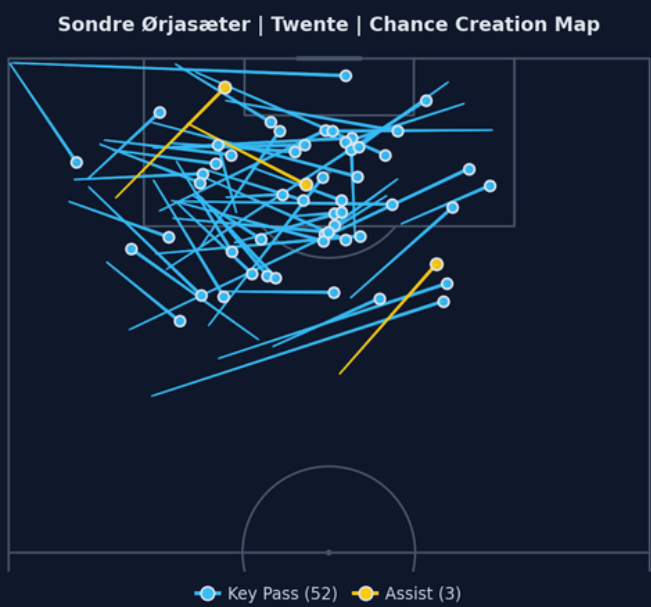


Territorial Impact

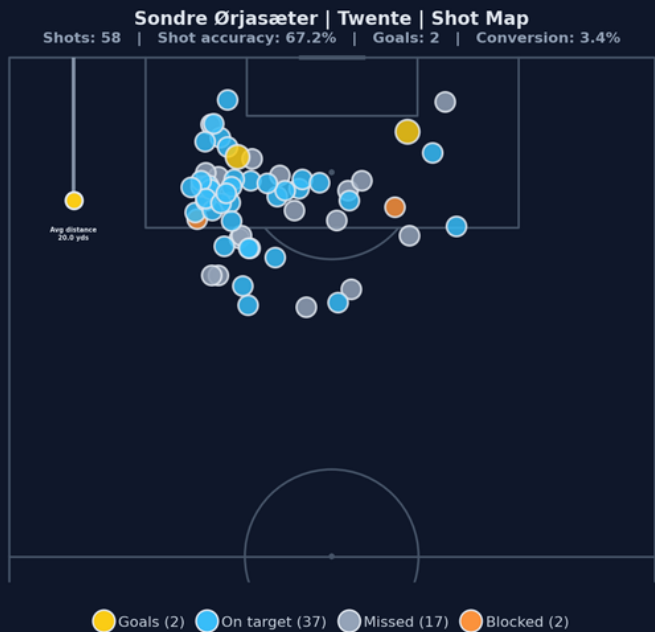
- Ørjasæter helps Twente gain territory not only through carries, but also through his ability to receive frequently in advanced left-sided zones.
- His final-third reception profile shows how often he becomes a high outlet on the left, especially in wide and left half-space areas.
- Once receiving, he turns possession into forward momentum through repeated carries, progressive runs and direct attacks toward the box.
- His best carrying actions come when he can attack space from wide or left half-space zones, especially with support around him to create inside or outside options.

Statistical & Data Analysis | Final Actions, Turnover Risk & Defensive Work

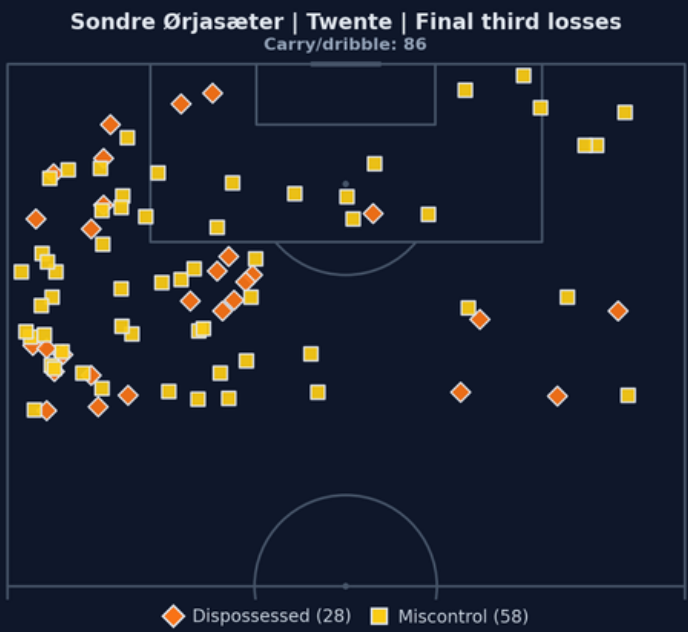

- Chance creation is heavily concentrated on the **left channel and in the left half-space**.
- Ørjasæter creates both from wide deliveries and from cut-ins, where he can slip passes into the box.



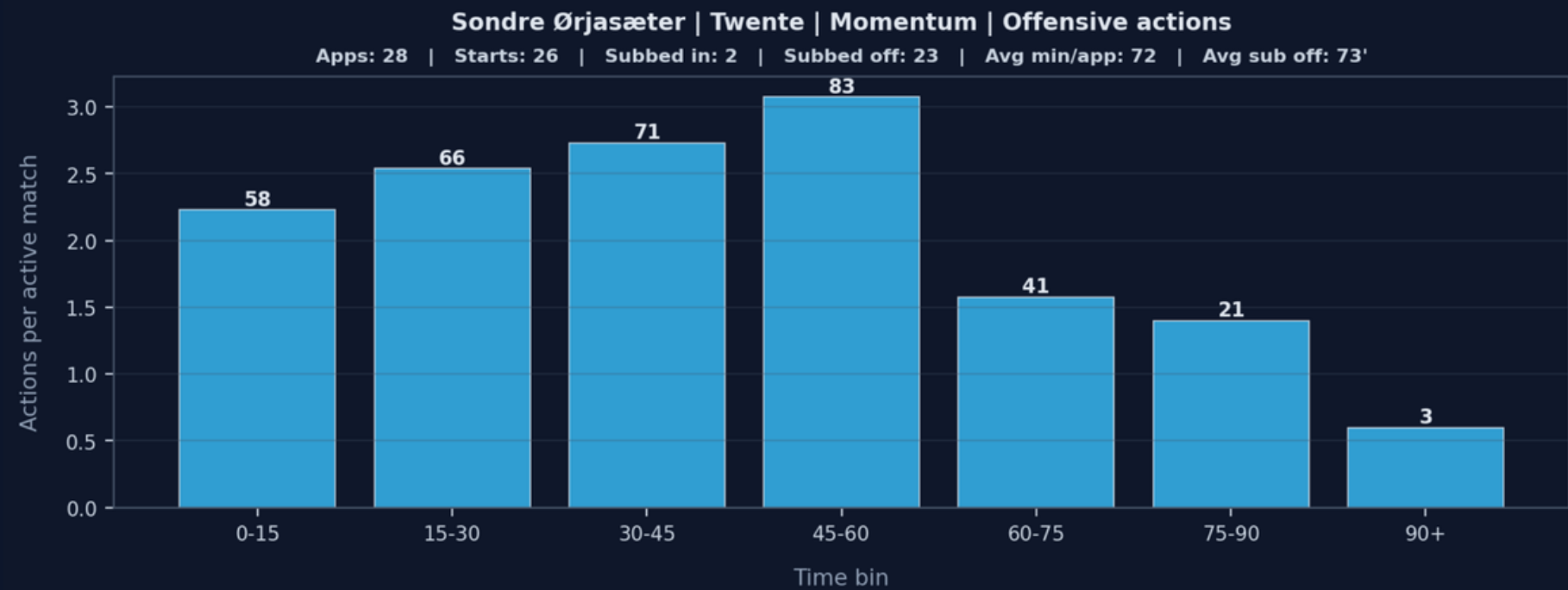
- Generates high shot volume and regularly attacks the left side of the box.
- Despite frequent shot involvement, his **conversion rate remains low**, reinforcing finishing efficiency as a key development point.



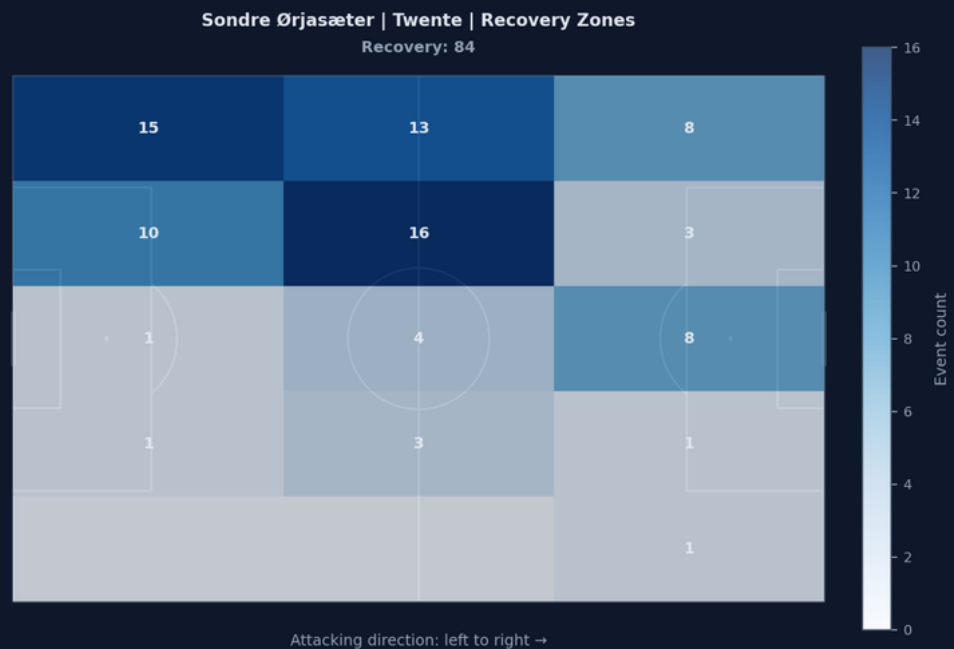
- High number of carry/dribble losses reflects the risk attached to his aggressive carrying style.

Profile Reading

- Ørjasæter’s attacking value is clear: he creates chances, carries into dangerous zones and generates regular shooting situations from the left side.
- The concern is not involvement, but efficiency. His final action can become cleaner, especially when finishing or releasing the ball after aggressive carries.
- His turnover profile is partly explained by role. He takes high-risk actions in crowded areas, but the next step is reducing avoidable losses near transition-sensitive zones.
- Defensively, he contributes more through recoveries than dominant duelling. His work rate is useful, but he is not a high-impact ball-winner or aerial outlet.



- Involvement is high through the first hour, peaking between 45–60 minutes.
- The drop after 60’ should be read alongside his substitution pattern, not only as a physical decline.
- He maintains strong attacking impact while on the pitch.



Scouting Profile

Technical

- Strong **ball-carrying quality**, with the ability to progress possession from wide areas into the final third and penalty area.
- High-level **creative passing** close to goal through key passes, cut-backs and passes into dangerous zones.
- Confident **1v1 attacker**, using balance, body feints and timing to create separation.
- Offers useful delivery from both deeper and advanced wide positions, especially when he has **created space before crossing**.

Development Focus

- **Finishing efficiency** remains the main technical step, as his execution has not yet matched the quality of his attacking positions.
- Can improve final action selection after beating the first defender, especially in crowded zones.

Physical

- Has the **mobility and stamina** to repeat high-intensity attacking actions throughout the match.
- Carries with good **balance and body control**, allowing him to stay stable through contact and pressure.
- Shows useful **acceleration** over short distances, particularly when receiving with space ahead.
- Comfortable **receiving under pressure**, where he can protect the ball and turn into forward actions.

Development Focus

- **Aerial duels** remain a limitation, reducing his value as a direct wide outlet when the ball is played long.
- Late-game involvement should be monitored, although the drop after 60 minutes is strongly linked to his substitution pattern.

Tactical

- Ørjasæter is a **key left-sided outlet**, receiving frequently in advanced zones and giving the team a clear route forward.
- Most effective when starting wide before attacking inside through **carries, combinations or diagonal actions** into the box.
- Can **support progression** by receiving deeper, but his highest value comes when he receives in the final third.
- Offers strong **box presence** through both carries and receptions, making him a direct box threat rather than only a wide creator.

Development Focus

- Can become more consistent when play moves away from his side, adjusting earlier to stay connected to the next attacking phase.
- **Counterpressing** impact can improve, especially after turnovers from his own high-risk actions.

Psychological

- Plays with **confidence** and **ambition** in possession, regularly attempting actions that can break defensive structure.
- Shows **patience** in some final-third moments, waiting for the passing lane rather than forcing the first available option.
- His risk appetite is part of his attacking value, giving him the confidence to take defenders on and create separation.

Development Focus

- Can improve reaction after mistakes, especially by staying active immediately after turnovers.

Left Winger Comparison & Transfer Fit

PSV Context

- Ball-dominant side with elite possession control.
- Strong territory and penetration profile.
- High attacking volume, frequent shots and chance creation.
- Uses width and crossing, but within a controlled possession model.
- Low directness, so wide players must combine, receive high and sustain attacks.

- Experienced wide attacker with strong end product and crossing quality.
- Consistent chance creation and high delivery value from the left side.
- Intelligent movement and half-space use in possession.
- Immediate impact and reliability, but age limits long-term pathway value.



Couhaib Driouech

Transfer Rumor

- Young left winger with strong wide threat and direct attack intent.
- Good crossing and delivery quality with willingness to run in behind.
- Useful defensive work rate and pressing contribution off the ball.
- High talent profile, but transfer-rumour uncertainty can affect pathway.

Why Ørjasæter Fits PSV

- PSV’s high-possession and high-territory style suits Ørjasæter’s game as a left winger who attacks advanced spaces through carries, combinations and box entries.
- He offers strong chance creation, dribbling threat and final-third involvement, giving PSV another reliable left-sided outlet.
- With Perišić at 37 and Driouech linked with transfer movement, Ørjasæter could fit both as an immediate rotation option and a longer-term solution.
- PSV looks like a strong pathway if squad space opens, because the tactical environment matches his strengths and could help scale his impact at a higher level.
